• Most verbs → add -ed.

play → played

talk → talked

share → shared

visit → visited

finish → finished

carry → carried

mix → mixed

crash → crashed

cry → cried

Sometimes you have to drop the 'c' or change the 'y' to an 'i' first.

• Some verbs are irregular.

bring → brought

tell → told

teach → taught

win → won

do → did

run → ran

go → went

drink → drank

make → made

• Some verbs stay the same.

hit → hit

cost → cost

cut → cut

quit → quit

hurt → hurt

put → put
